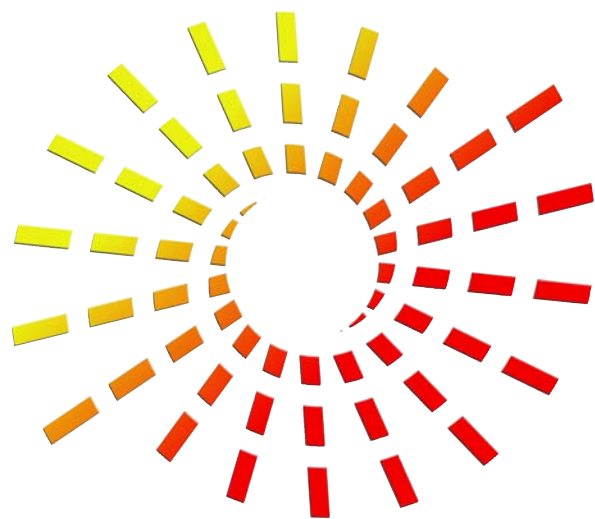


# SOL 2008
